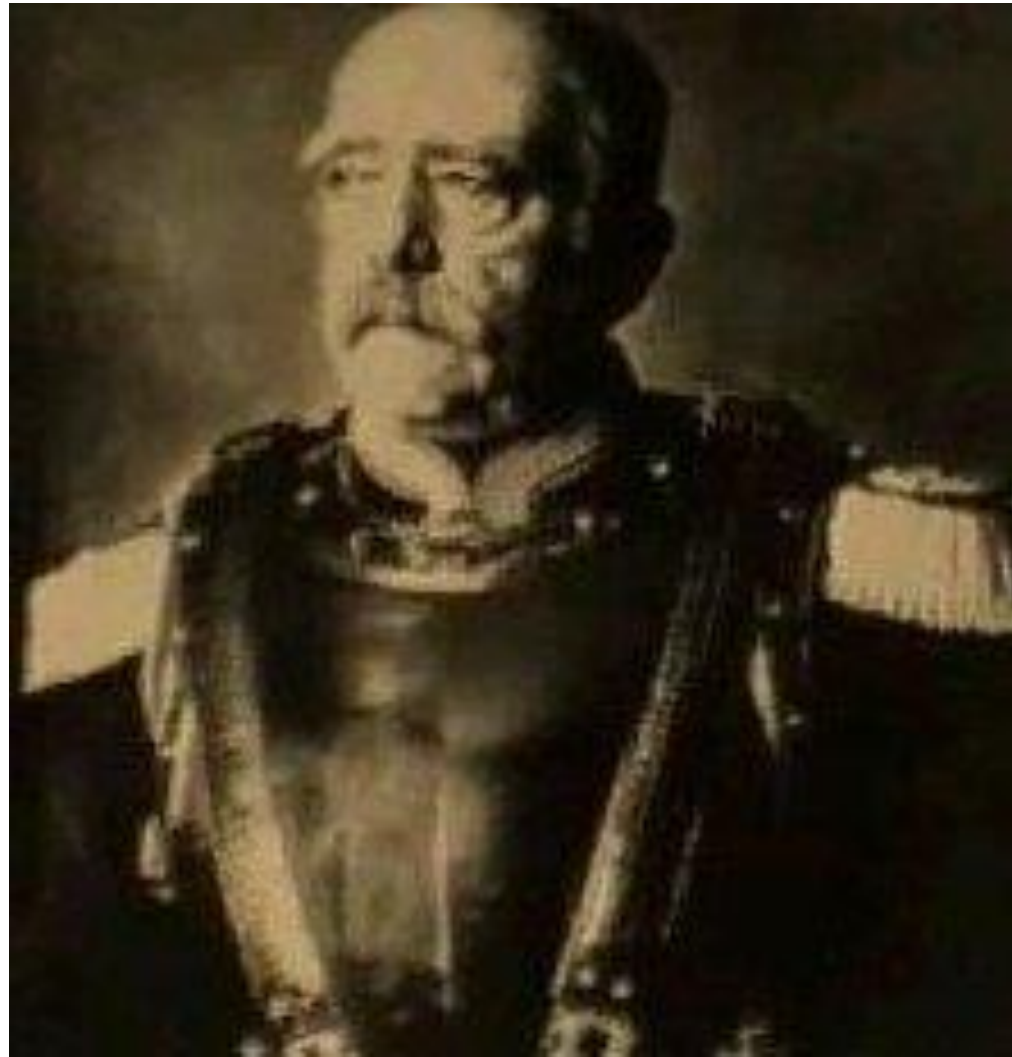

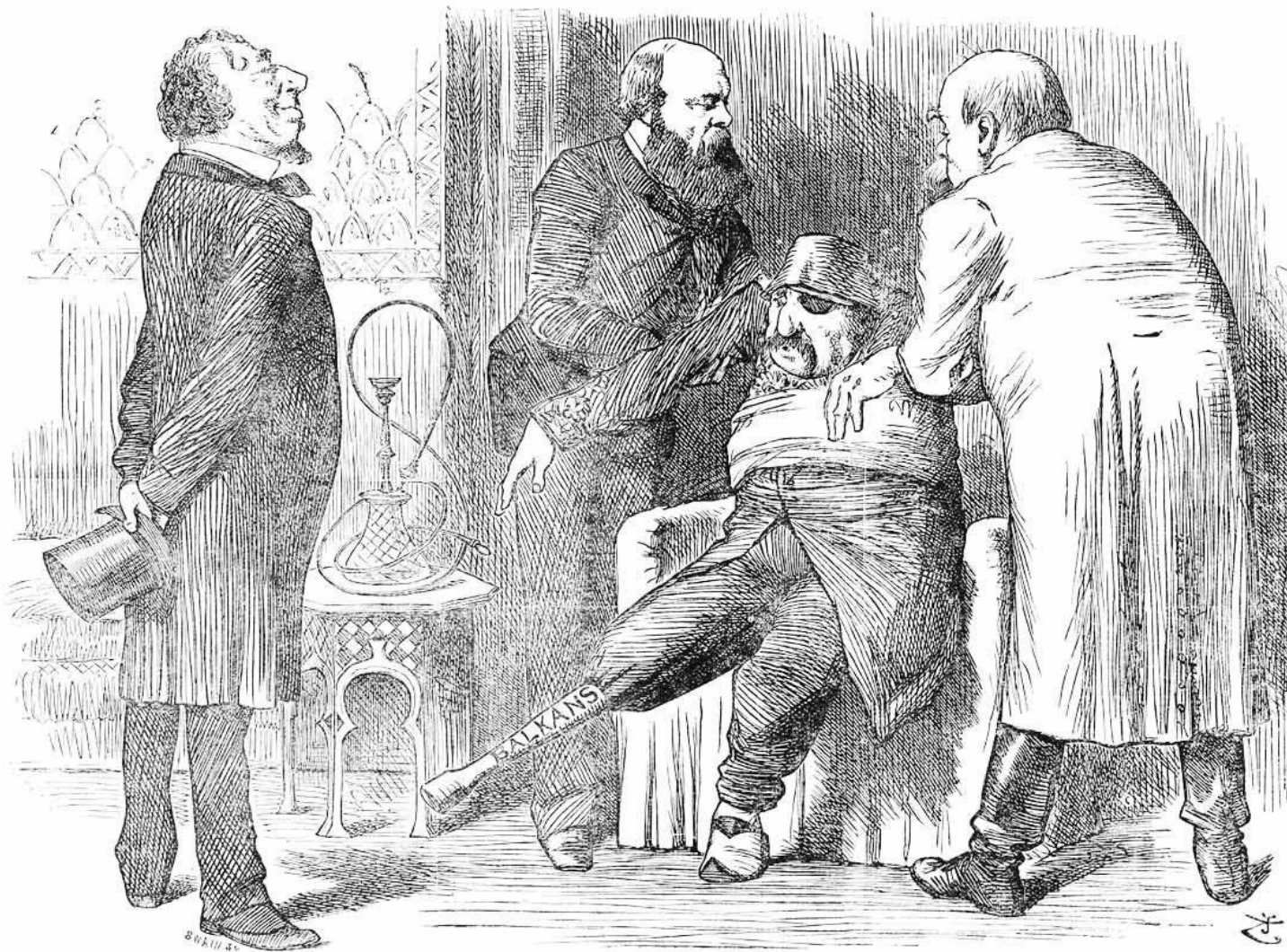
PROVISIONAL AND REVISED BORDERS OF BULGARIA (1878).
